

Update for 5/29/2020

- While the Governor's order does take steps to re-open businesses in Minnesota, our mission to protect our residents remain our priority.
- The greatest COVID-19 risk comes from the movement of persons into and out of a facility. Anyone who leaves and then returns to a facility can potentially bring COVID-19 into our facility.
- As senior care settings continue to be a "hot spot" for outbreaks of COVID-19, we must take all appropriate steps to ensure that our residents and staff are safe from the transmission of the virus. Until we receive further clarification from CMS and MDH, visitor restrictions remain in place as we work on plans to re-open our setting and warmly welcome you back.
- We value the connection between residents and families and ask for patience as we work with the state officials to establish ways to secure safe visits in the future that protect our residents and staff and limit the potential transmission of the virus to our broader community.
- Until we receive any notice to the contrary, limitations for resident transports out of the facility remain in place, including the recommendation that if a resident leaves the facility to stay with a family/friend member, exposure to persons with COVID19 cannot be ruled out. Upon the residents return, the resident must be quarantined in a private room.

We will continue to update all of our families as we are updated.
